Bryn Mawr Neighborhood Association Yearly Events

Each year the Bryn Mawr Neighborhood Association sponsors events to bring neighbors together where they can build relationships that support a healthy community. These events are supported by membership donations, in-kind contributions from our local businesses and neighbors, ticket sales, and Community Participation Program (CPP) allocations from the City of Minneapolis.

Festival of Garage Sales - Held the first full weekend in May

This iconic neighborhood-wide garage sale has a long history. Started in the 1970s, the festival draws people from all over the city and beyond to Bryn Mawr for over 100 garage sales, along with eating and shopping at our local stores.

BMNA Annual Meeting – Held the second Wednesday in May

The annual meeting and potluck dinner takes place each year, as articulated in our by-laws. This is a membership business meeting where neighbors can vote for association representatives and officers, discuss neighborhood issues, hear from elected officials, and greet new and longtime neighbors

Garden Tour – Held every other year in July

The garden tour showcases over 10 private gardens owned and nurtured by passionate neighborhood gardeners. During this self-guided tour, you'll not only experience the wonders of beautiful gardens but will take home many ideas and tips from the gardeners at each site

Ice Cream Social and Scoop Off - Held the third week of July

Each year local ice cream shops donate ice cream, custards, and sorbet for our annual scoop off, attracting over 500 neighbors to taste and vote for their favorite flavors. It's a chance to dance to a local band and socialize.

Sip and Stroll - Held the second week of October

Sponsored by over 15 Bryn Mawr businesses, neighbors visit local stores and restaurants, with a final drawing for prizes and music at our neighborhood coffee shop, Cuppa Java.

Harvest Dinner — Held the third week of November

This fall gathering at Bryn Mawr Community School brings neighbors together for a potluck dinner and chance to compete with others for the best "dish". The BMNA provides the main meal, with salads, side dishes, and dessert brought by those who attend.

Anwatin Craft Fair - Held the first week of December

The craft fair takes place in conjunction with Taste of Anwatin, a middle school event featuring band and choir concerts and an Empty Bowls project. Crafters purchase a table and set up their wares in the school gym. The craft fair has a long history of featuring unique neighborhood goods, including homemade soap, crocheted and knitted hats and scarves, baked goods, jewelry, carvings, and locally written books

Saturnalia Winter Festival - Held the second Saturday of December

An afternoon celebration of winter, this downtown Bryn Mawr street festival features horse-drawn hay wagon rides, drum corps dancing, and roasting marshmallows over open fire pits. After all the outdoor festivities, enjoy an evening dance at the local coffee shop.

<u>Winter Fest</u> — Held in February each year.

Winter Fest is fun night of music, food, and a silent auction to benefit the BMNA.



History of Bryn Mawr

Bryn Mawr means "big hill" in Welsh. Bryn Mawr was developed from farmland beginning in the mid-1800's when it was promoted as a "garden suburb" or "amenity zone," because of its proximity to the lakes and an abundance of green space. Many workers of the Minneapolis and St. Louis Railway yard lived here prior to the 1960s. Pocketed roughly between Cedar Lake Park to the South, Wirth Park to the North and West, Bassett's Creek to the North, and Bryn Mawr Meadows to the East; the neighborhood is characterized by its long-time stability and its quietude. It remains surrounded by over 650 acres of parks, lakes, and trails, and retains much of its original small town charm, while having very good access to some of the best urban and natural features of Minneapolis and the nearby suburbs. Bryn Mawr is the northwestern anchor to the Minneapolis beautiful chain of lakes, yet it is just minutes from shopping and business centers, a number of important historic sites, a wide variety of cultural and entertainment venues, two major sports facilities, and several colleges and universities. A part of the Calhoun-Isles Planning district, it is in the northwestern corner of the 7th Ward.


