• *CEE Energy Project:* Have 10 coupons left for free home visits to conduct energy audit. Invited to competition for a grant. Need volunteer Jan 21 8-9:30am. Andrew Krahling volunteered.

- Downtown Project (lighting & striping)- New LED lighting installed at corner of Penn and Cedar Lake Road. No comments yet. Banners group needs to meet for final decisions.
- Raingarden Project- 90% done. Have \$18,000 for implementations. Half of coupons purchased. 15 more available. Free consultation and free design services. Get \$\$\$ for implementation. Need to clarify to residents that funds are available. Metro Blooms working with us.
- Community Solar Power Project- Half done with reimbursement to residents. 1 year extension was granted for distribution of funds, \$21,000 left. Add participants' testimonials to website.
- NRP axed by City Council but \$7200-\$18000 is still available for Bryn Mawr projects. \$17000 to \$28000 was lost. Active groups continue to work on proposals to compete. Had \$330,000 initially.

 - *5th annual project*-Deadline for proposals is Feb. 20th. Could use NRP \$\$\$ for \$2000 budget.

- Capstone (Humphrey Institute) Project- Rick Carter is working with Capstone Class on Penn LRT Station. Monthly updates will be presented. A presentation on conclusions will be made at end of class.
- Cedar Lake Parks Ass'n Charette-Barry/Jay There has been a delay in draft statement. Citizens Advisory Committee is busy on other projects. Funding in place?
